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Daniel Ciurea is a Medical Doctor, with a master's degree in Health and Social Services.

He acted as Director of Programs for the Foundation Center for Health Policies and Services, Bucharest, Romania, for the last 16 years.

He has extensive experience in working in health services management and financing projects in Romania, Moldova, Turkey, Belarus and Georgia in the last 24 years, where he worked with central institutions like Ministry of Health, Health Insurance Fund, Centre for Health Statistics, National Institute for Public Health etc.

Also, he has participated in or coordinated multiple internationally funded projects (WHO, UNICEF, SDC, PHARE, WB, USAID, SOROS, UNDP, GF) in the fields of health policy, health management, health financing and public health.

In Romania and Moldova, Daniel Ciurea worked extensively for the hospital system reform, especially the reform of the emergency services and hospital payment mechanisms.

A selection of relevant assignments in emergency systems' reform and pandemics' response is presented below.

From 1998 to 2000, he worked as a consultant in the project "Rehabilitation of Regional Emergency Medical Services in 6 districts of Romania – (REMSSy 2)", financed by Swiss Development and Cooperation Agency, Romania.

From 2010 to 2018 he acted as strategic planner and technical backstopping for the project "REPEMOL - Regionalization of the Pediatric Emergency and Intensive Care Services in Moldova", financed by Swiss Development and Cooperation Agency, Moldova

In 2020 and 2021 he worked with WHO Moldova to establish the financing mechanism and formula for hospitals' response to COVID-19 pandemic.

Since 2020 he works with National Institute of Virology as Healthcare Databases Expert for the project STAMINA - „Demonstration of intelligent decision support for pandemic crisis prediction and management within and across European borders”, Horizon 2020 EU Research and Innovation programme.

Presently, in March 2022, he works with WHO Barcelona Office for Health Systems Financing for providing Romanian system's specifics for a survey to map the health financing arrangements for people fleeing the Ukraine conflict in European region countries.
