**“Demonstration of intelligent decision support for pandemic crisis prediction and management within and across European borders”**



**A new EU-funded project has been launched to create a smart platform for support pandemic prediction and management.**

*Infectious diseases have the potential to pose cross-border threats to public health. Managing this type of crisis remains a serious challenge due to the number of people involved, legislative, administrative and cultural differences and the lack of cross-border crisis management infrastructures.*

**In response to this problem, 37 organizations in Europe (and outside the EU) have joined forces to implement in 2 years an innovative H2020 project.**



***The STAMINA project combines state-of-the-art technologies not currently used in public health or disaster and pandemic planning systems. The main result of the project consists in a set of intelligent tools, which has a map-based interface, with a supporting role in the decision-making process.***

**The STAMINA project was designed from the perspective of a user, with *five main objectives.***



- 1. Creating a set of guidelines and best practices for improving pandemic preparedness and response.***
- 2. Providing stakeholders with new, easy-to-use software tools that complement EU-wide systems.***
- 3. Increasing diagnostic capacity.***
- 4. Improving cooperation between EU Member States and neighboring countries.***
- 5. Ensuring the sustainability of the STAMINA solution.***
