1	Romanian Ministry of Health (MS)	<p>The Romanian Ministry of Health is a specialized body of the central public administration, with legal personality, subordinated to the Government.</p> <p>The Romanian Ministry of Health fulfills the following main attributions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • elaborates policies, strategies and action programs in the field of population health, in accordance with the Government Program, coordinates and controls the implementation of policies, strategies and programs in the field of population health, at national, regional and local level; • evaluates and monitors the population state of health, takes measures for its improvement and informs the Government regarding the health indicators, the evolution trends and about the necessary measures for their improvement; • regulates the organization and functioning of the health system; • monitors, controls and evaluates the activity of health institutions and takes measures to improve the quality of medical care provided to the population; • ensures, in collaboration with the central and local public administration institutions, the human, material and financial resources necessary for the functioning of the institutions in the public health system; • collaborates with the representatives of the central and local public administration authorities, with those of the civil society and with the mass media for the purpose of educating the population for health and adopting a healthy lifestyle; • participates in the limitation of the effects appeared after the disasters, calamities and epidemics in its field of competence; • represents the Government of Romania in the relations with the World Health Organization and with other international bodies, in fields of interest; • elaborates, implements and coordinates national health programs, in order to achieve the objectives of the public health policy; • manages, through specialized structures, the international financial assistance programs for supporting the health reform and for increasing the quality of the medical assistance provided to the population; • collaborates with the Ministry of Education, Research, Youth and Sports and implements projects and programs <p>In order to exercise its attributions, the Romanian Ministry of Health is empowered to request and receive, in accordance with the law, information from: central and local public administration authorities, public institutions and legal persons under private law with activity in its field of competence.</p>
2	Ministry of Internal Affairs (MAI)	<p>The general duties of the M.A.I. in the field of internal affairs</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Establishes, according to the law, measures for the protection of fundamental human rights and freedoms, as well as public and private property. • Organizes and carries out, through specialized structures, according to the competence, activities for preventing and combating terrorism, organized crime, drug trafficking and illicit drug trafficking, human trafficking, illegal migration, cybercrime, as well as other criminal phenomena and antisocial facts.

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Organizes, guides and coordinates the protection activity of persons, goods, objectives and values and organizes the guarding of special importance objectives given in competence according to the law. • Ensures, according to the competencies, the development of the activity for carrying out the investigations in connection with the commission of some deeds provided by the criminal law. • Organizes the activity of witness protection. • Requests from public authorities, from natural or legal persons information, data and documents necessary in order to fulfill the attributions established by law and within its limits; may reward the natural persons who provide support to the ministry, for the fulfillment of the specific attributions, from the fund distributed with this destination, under the conditions established by order of the minister. • Ensures compliance with the state border regime of Romania. • Establishes and uses the National Register of Weapons and the Criminal Record. • Establishes and uses the National Aliens Registration System; ensures the observance of the legal regime of foreigners on the Romanian territory. • Ensures the establishment, evidence, selection, preservation and use of documents from the National Archival Fund. • Organizes and executes the medical and psychological insurance of specific missions. • Leads the activity of information and internal protection. • Guides and controls the activity of the prefect for the fulfillment of the Government Program. • Ensures, through the subordinated specialized structures, the application of the strategy and the Government Program in the field of civil service management and civil servants, the training and improvement of professional training specialized in the activity of registration of persons, as well as the prevention and management of civil emergency situations. • It constitutes and uses the National Informatics System for the Registration of Persons. <p>The operational structure of the Ministry of Internal Affairs, which coordinates at national level the activities of prevention and management of emergencies, ensuring and coordinating the human, material, financial and other resources necessary to restore normality, including activities for providing qualified first aid and emergency medical assistance, within the units and compartments for receiving emergencies, until hospitalization. The department operationally coordinates the county ambulance services, respectively of the Bucharest municipality, ICU / CPU, as well as the Salva Mont public services.</p>
3	Ministry of National Defense (MApN)	<p>The Romanian Ministry of National Defense has the following duties and responsibilities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • the establishment of the force structure and the realization of the fighting capacity of the army for the fulfillment of the specific missions incumbent on it; • establishment, disbandment, dislocation and redeployment of units and formations; • elaboration of draft normative acts regarding the country's defense; • the defense of one's own legitimate rights and interests in the relations with the public authorities, the institutions of any nature, as well as with any natural or legal person, Romanian or foreign, through own structures; • concluding treaties at departmental level and technical agreements in the field of cooperation with the armies of other states;

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • coordinating the policy and integration activities in the international organizations to which Romania is part, for its own structures, maintaining and developing the politico-military cooperation relations with the other states and ensuring the representation of the army in the relations with the armies of other states; • management of information for defense, intelligence activity, counterintelligence and military security, as well as collaboration with the services / structures of intelligence, counterintelligence and security of other states or international organizations to which Romania is part; • carrying out integrated defense planning; • financing and ensuring the execution of the own budget; • training of commands and troops, specialized training of active and reserve personnel; • computerization of all its fields of activity; • human resources management, organization and management of military education; • environmental protection in the activities they carry out; • organizing and leading the information and public relations activity; • issuing specific regulations for the organization and functioning of military structures, committees and councils set up for decision-making; • increasing the quality of the personnel life, ensuring the religious assistance of the military and civilian personnel, as well as its social, medical and legal assistance, in accordance with the legal provisions; • implementation, at the level of the ministry, of public policies and public administration reform programs; • management of logistics activities; • endowment with weapons, combat equipment, equipment and materials specific to the army, relations with the national defense industry and international cooperation in the field; • the coordination of the foreign trade activity regarding the import and export of products for military destination, in accordance with the law; • approving, within the limits of its competence, the technical-economic documentation for the own investment works, the execution of the own investment works, as well as the follow-up of the execution, within the established terms, of all the investment works; • mobilization of the army, establishment of reserve forces, requisition of goods and calling of individuals to provide services in the public interest; • publishing publications in their own fields of activity; • scientific research, inventions and innovations in the military, as well as the protection of intellectual property rights over the research results;
4	National Institute for Public Health (INSP)	<p>INSP is a public institution with legal personality, subordinated to the Ministry of Health.</p> <p>The Institute is the health unit that provides technical and methodological guidance to the public health network, monitors the population health, communicable and non-communicable diseases to identify community health problems, develops methodology, tools and indicators for monitoring and evaluation of health services and programs public health promotion and health education and ensures the existence of an integrated information and IT system for public health management.</p> <p>The institute aims to:</p>

- prevention, surveillance and control of communicable and non-communicable diseases;
 - health monitoring;
 - health promotion and health education;
 - occupational health assessment;
 - monitoring health in relation to the environment;
 - elaboration of regulations in the field of public health;
 - ensuring public health management;
 - development of specific public health services;
 - organization, management, guidance and verification from a technical and methodological point of view, on the entire territory of the country, of the health information system;
 - organization, management and control of the information system in the sanitary field;
 - organization and administration of the national database on health statistics;
 - elaboration of indicators for evaluating the health condition and the efficiency of the sanitary network.
- The Institute has the following **general responsibilities**:
- ensures the technical and methodological guidance of the public health network, depending on the field of competence;
 - participates in the elaboration of strategies and policies in the field of competence;
 - elaborates drafts of normative acts, norms, methodologies and instructions regarding the specific fields within the public health;
 - performs expertise, provides technical assistance and performs public health services, at the request of natural or legal persons;
 - monitors the health status of the population, communicable and non-communicable diseases, in order to identify community health problems;
 - ensures the system of epidemiological surveillance, as well as early warning and rapid response and participates in the exchange of information within the European network of epidemiological surveillance in the field of communicable diseases;
 - participates in conducting field epidemiological investigations, on its own initiative, at the request of the Ministry of Health or local public health authorities;
 - elaborates the methodology, tools and indicators for monitoring and evaluation of public health services and programs, health promotion and health education;
 - participates in the medical education process of specialization and improvement in specific fields within health;
 - carries out research and development activities in the field of public health and public health management;
 - collects, analyzes and disseminates statistical data on public health;
 - ensures the existence of an integrated information and informatics system for public health management;
- m) ensures the economic-financial, administrative and legal activity of the Institute and of the national and regional centers of public health both through its own staff and through the specialized staff taken over from the National Center for Improvement in Health Bucharest, institution that is being abolished, according to the law.
- collects, analyzes and disseminates data on the health status of the population;
 - elaborates and submits to the Ministry of Health the Annual Report of the health status of the population, based on the centralized data and their analysis;

5	Department for Emergency Situations (DSU)	<p>The department for emergency situations is an operational structure without legal personality of the Ministry of Internal Affairs, with permanent attributions of coordination, at national level, of the activities of prevention and management of emergency situations, ensuring and coordinating human, material, financial and other resources necessary to restore normality, including qualified first aid and emergency medical care in emergency units and departments (ICU / CPU).</p> <p>The department for emergency situations operationally coordinates the county ambulance services, respectively the Bucharest municipality, ICU / CPU, as well as the public Salvamont services. The department provides the technical secretariat for the Inter-ministerial Commission for technical support (CIMST). CIMST is organized and functions as an inter-ministerial body, in order to coordinate the activities regarding the organization, functioning and financing of the National System of Emergency and Qualified First Aid, as well as of the professional services for emergency situations.</p> <p>The department for emergency situations monitors the operative activity of the structures it has in coordination. The technical and organizational conditions regarding the operational coordination of the Salvamont public services are carried out based on the protocols concluded between the county inspectorates for emergency situations and the local public administration authorities that have set up such services, approved by the Department.</p>
6	General Inspectorate for Emergency Situations (IGSU)	<p>IGSU objectives:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - streamlining the actions of prevention and management of emergency situations -release and first aid SMURD -saving people and limiting the damage caused by floods, landslides, seismic movements, epidemics, epizootics, snowfall, drought -assistance of people in critical situations -intervention to technological, radiological, nuclear, biological accidents <p>IGSU missions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • monitoring, evaluation, research of the emergencies causes; • information and preventive education of the population and its warning, notification of the public administration authorities, about the possibility / imminence of emergency situations; • search, release and rescue of persons; • evacuation of persons, population or endangered goods, by ensuring evacuation measures, installation of disaster camps, participation in the transport of the population and certain categories of goods; • destruction of ice caps or clearing of watercourses;

7	Inspectorate for Emergency Situations in Calarasi (ISU)	Is a specialized intervention structure in emergency situations subordinated to the General Inspectorate for Emergency Situations within the Ministry of Administration and Interior
8	Mobile Emergency Service for Resuscitation and Extrication (SMURD)	<p>SMURD missions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • intervention in cases where one or more people are in a life-threatening situation due to an acute illness or injury; • intervention in cases that require first aid in a short time; • intervention in cases requiring release or other rescue operations; • ensuring medical protection for the personnel of the IGSU intervention teams at specific missions with risk of injury; • intervention in collective accidents and calamities <p>The SMURD structure has integrated release and resuscitation teams, specialized in providing emergency medical and technical assistance, as well as teams with paramedical staff, specialized in providing qualified first aid.</p>
9	General Inspectorate of Aviation (IGAV)	<p>In 2014, the Department for Emergency Situations was established, an operational structure without legal personality from the Ministry of Internal Affairs, with permanent attributions of coordination, at national level, of the activities of prevention and management of emergency situations, insurance and coordination of human, material, financial and other resources necessary to restore normality, including qualified first aid and emergency medical care in emergency units and compartments, hereinafter referred to as ICU / CPU, until hospitalization.</p> <p>The Department is headed by a Secretary of State, the head of the Department for Emergency Situations, appointed by decision of the Prime Minister, and in the exercise of his duties he coordinates the General Aviation Inspectorate (only for emergency management operations).</p> <p>General Aviation Inspectorate:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • provides air support to MAI. by performing operational flight missions in normal and crisis situations; • ensures the execution of emergency aeromedical transport missions, in cooperation with the Mobile Emergency, Resuscitation and Release Service;

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ensures the development of the flight activity within the General Aviation Inspectorate, according to the military and civil aeronautical regulations in force; • ensures the implementation, observance and adaptation of air safety policies to the specifics of the missions of the General Aviation Inspectorate; • collaborates with military aviation structures and civilian agencies involved in airspace management; • develops procedures and instructions for the application of military aviation regulations; • plans, organizes, coordinates and controls the forces and means engaged in the execution of permanent and temporary missions, according to the law, the orders of the Minister of Internal Affairs and of the General Inspector; • ensures the development of the ground and in-flight training process, in order to ensure the operational capacity necessary to fulfill the flight missions, in any meteorological conditions, day and night, in safety; • organizes and leads the activity of improving the entire staff, in order to raise the level of knowledge in the specialized fields, of the support and general disciplines; • ensures the formation and development of theoretical and practical skills, individual and collective, of the aeronautical personnel; • ensures the technical availability of aircraft, in accordance with the regulations in force; • leads the activity of selection, training and promotion of the staff, of its evaluation according to the professional, moral qualities and the obtained results; • organizes, leads and controls the logistical assurance activities of the missions; • ensures the implementation and observance of the norms of labor, environment and guarding and extinguishing fires; • ensures the organization and functioning of the communication and informatics system necessary for the development of the activities; • ensures the psycho-moral and physical training of the entire staff; • ensures and manages the resources necessary to carry out all activities.
10	Public Health Directorate (DSP) in Calarasi	<p>Mission</p> <p>The Public Health Directorate of Calarasi County is a public institution with legal personality that carries out its activity in order to implement national public health policies and programs, preventive medicine and state health inspection, health monitoring and organization of health statistics, as well as the planning and development of investments financed from the state budget for the health sector.</p>
11	City Hall (Calarasi)	<p>The mission of Călărași City Hall as authority of local public administration, with the role of ensuring respect for the fundamental rights and freedoms of citizens, the provisions of the Constitution, as well as the implementation of laws, decrees of the President of Romania, Government decisions and ordinances , of the decisions of the Local Council and to order the necessary measures for the application of normative orders and instructions at the level of the territorial administrative unit, is to be permanently at the service of the needs of the citizens and the local community, to solve them in a legal, transparent way , fair, competent and efficient, thus ensuring the prosperity of the inhabitants of Călărași municipality, by providing services at an adequate quality standard, in a national and international context.</p>

12	Calarasi County ambulance service (SAJ)	<p>Duties of the Medical Dispatcher:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Taking over calls for medical emergencies from the Single National System for Emergency Calls 112. • Taking over the calls for assisted or unassisted transport activities from the sanitary units of Călărași county. • Call recording in electronic format, emergency sorting and data transmission to the substations of the County Ambulance Service and the Mobile Emergency, Resuscitation and Release Service specifying the crew / crews that will travel. • Coordinating the activity of the medical services in the pre-hospital keeping in touch with the intervention crews, receiving reports about the interventions and assisting the first aid crews or the emergency crews without a doctor indicating the way to solve the case based on the report received. • Data transmission through the radio terminal in the sanitary facility. • Tracking through the GIS / GPS system of ambulances and emergency response vehicles equipped with satellite tracking and tracing systems. • Transfer of telephone calls, if necessary, directly to the sub-dispatcher of the agency that has priority. 13	National Network of Family Doctors (RMF)	<p>RMF is the largest and strongest medical professional company in Romania. 14	Local and regional hospitals	<p>All health units in the public and private system have the obligation to ensure the provision of medical care to all patients, in accordance with the provisions of the approved plan of measures.</p> <p>These are health units with public utility beds, with legal personality, in which medical services are carried out by specialties, which mainly provide emergency, specialized, curative, preventive and recovery medical care for hospitalized patients.</p> <p>In the exercise of their duties, hospitals collaborate through the staff they have, with the Health Insurance House of Bucharest, the Public Health Directorate of Bucharest, with bodies of the central and local public administration, with the managements of other health units and with other institutions interested in protecting the health of the population.</p> <p>Hospitals provides:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • specialized medical assistance for patients with complex pathologies addressed to a tertiary care center; • conducting specialized investigations and consultations, in order to establish the diagnosis, administration of treatment and other types of medical care, necessary for both hospitalized patients and those presented in a state of emergency; • continuity of medical assistance in all stages of disease evolution, through permanent cooperation of doctors from the same unit, or with doctors from other health units; • efficient use of specialized personnel and technical means of investigation and treatment; • continuous development and improvement of medical care, corresponding to the requirements of modern medicine; • management of personal / confidential medical data and information of the addressable patients; • ensuring sanitary and environmental conditions, so as to prevent the occurrence of infections associated with medical care; • participation in actions and programs to ensure the health of the population; • carrying out the activity of continuing medical education and research for doctors, nurses and also for other categories of staff <p>In relation to their attributions in medical care, the hospitals provides:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • prevention and control of acute diseases, communicable diseases, occupational, chronic and degenerative diseases; • medical services which include: consultations, investigations, diagnosis, medical and / or surgical treatments, care, recovery, medicines, sanitary materials, medical devices, accommodation and meals; • the conditions for medical investigations, treatment, food hygiene and prevention of infections associated with medical care (according to the orders of the Romanian Minister of Health); • are responsible for the medical control and supervision of certain categories of patients; • qualified first aid and emergency medical care, without any discrimination, regardless of nationality, age, sex, race, political and religious beliefs, ethnicity, sexual orientation, social origin or whether or not the patient has health insurance; • observance of the inter-clinical transfer protocol elaborated by order of the Romanian Minister of Health;

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • compliance with the criteria for emergency hospitalization of patients consulted / assisted at ICU-SMURD and the criteria for emergency transfer to other hospitals - established by implementing rules (emergency services are included in the forces planned under the command of the Chief Inspector of the General Inspectorate for Emergency Situations - in situations of collective accidents, calamities and disasters, the staff of hospital emergency services cannot participate in strikes or other vindictive actions - which may decrease the capacity to intervene or the quality of the medical act itself); • first aid and emergency assistance to any person in critical condition, and after stabilization, providing medical transport to another unit, as appropriate; • an action plan for health care in case of war, disasters, terrorist attacks, social conflicts and other critical situations; • the risk factors from the living and working environment and their influence on the health status of the population; • informing the patient or close persons about the disease and obtaining his / her consent or / or the persons entitled, according to the law, in order to carry out the treatments; • preventing and combating infections associated with healthcare; • consultations, investigations, treatments and other medical care, necessary for hospitalized patients; • correct diagnosis and therapeutic conduct for hospitalized patients; • supply and distribution of medicines; • supply of cleaning and disinfection substances and materials; • an adequate nutrition, both from a qualitative and quantitative point of view, respecting the menus and the food allowance, according to the legislation in force; • the necessary conditions for the application of occupational safety and health measures, as well as fire protection according to the norms in force; • during the quarantine period it limits the access of the visitors to the hospital, and in some sections, according to the provisions of the legislation, the visit is completely forbidden.
15	Firefighters	<p>The General Inspectorate and the territorial structures are composed of 42 operational centers and over 280 operational subunits. The necessary staff is provided by the dedicated training institutions: "Alexandru Ioan Cuza" Police Academy Bucharest - Faculty of Fire and Non-Commissioned Officers of Fire and Civil Protection "Pavel Zăgănescu" Boldești.</p> <p>As an integrator of the National Emergency Management System, created in 2004, IGSU coordinates the actions of institutions involved in emergency management, ensuring the function of national contact point in relation to international governmental and non-governmental organizations with responsibilities in the field.</p> <p>The firefighters are part of the personnel of the intervention, rescue and first aid teams, within the voluntary / private services for emergency situations, in order to defend life, public and / or private property against fires and other calamities, in the competent sectors established with the approval of the inspectorates. They lead the rescue operations</p>
16	Romanian Red Cross	<p>The National Red Cross Society of Romania is a humanitarian organization, member of the International Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement, auxiliary to public authority and empowered by law to provide humanitarian assistance in case of disasters and to support vulnerable people.</p> <p>The main attributions of the National Red Cross Society of Romania are (Law no. 139/1995, Art. 11.):</p>
